To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, Karl Nuchterlein, a citizen of Germany, residing at Dresden, Germany, have invented a new, original, and ornamental Design for Cameras, of which the following is a specification, reference being had to the accompanying drawings, forming part thereof.

In the drawings:

Figure 1 is a rear perspective view of a camera showing my new design, with the hood unfolded.

Figure 2 is a top plan view of the camera with the hood folded.

Figure 3 is a front perspective view of the camera with the lens cap in place, and the hood folded.

Figure 4 is an enlarged perspective view of the camera showing the front and bottom portions and with the hood unfolded.

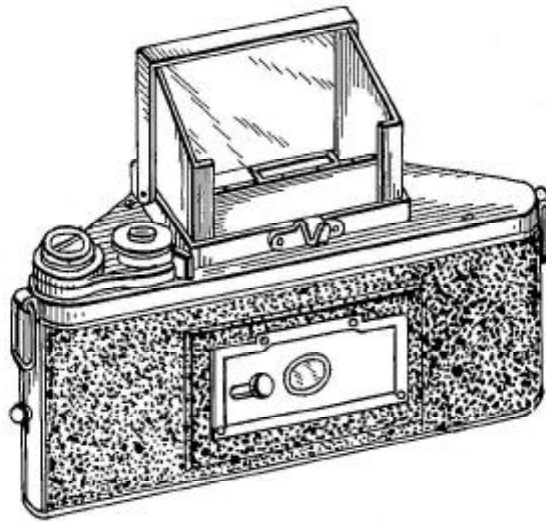
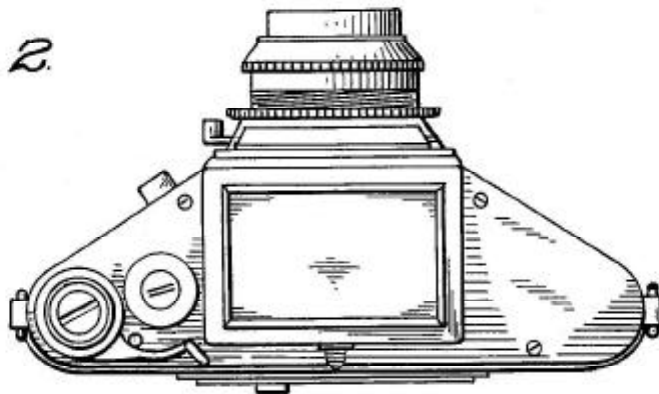

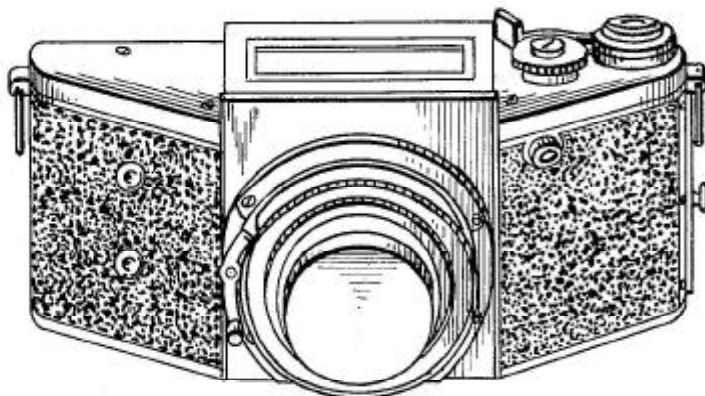
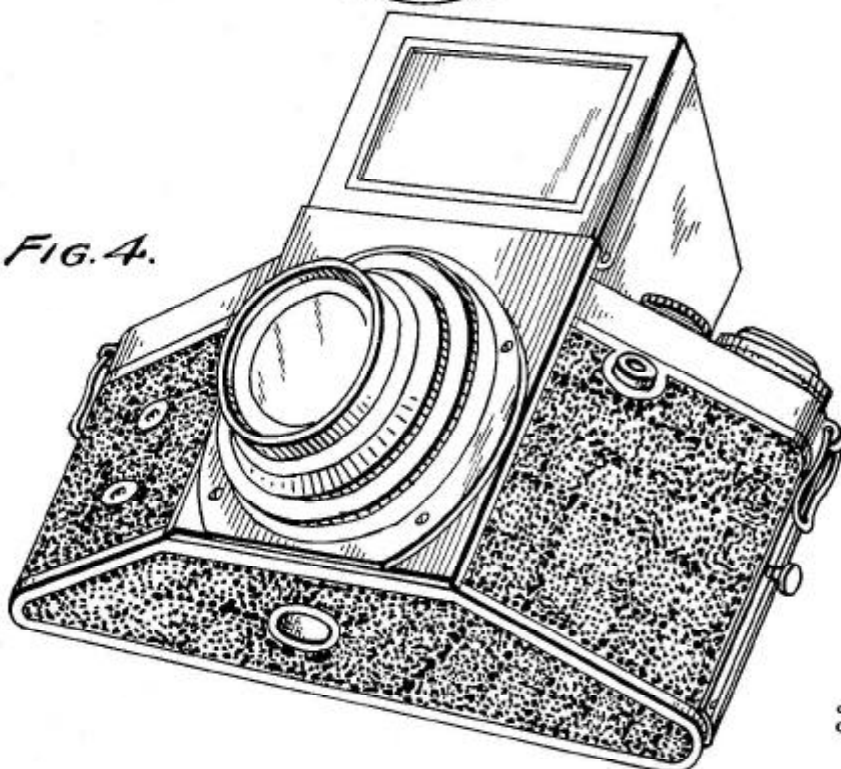
