

No 7: HYPONAR FLASH HOLDER

THIS IS A FLASH BRACKET for the Exakta with Hyponar. There were three for sale, on eBay in December 2004, by George Themelis. This was a small custom order.

The set consists of three items:

- High quality custom-machined bracket. The bracket screws to the bottom of the camera and holds the flash at an angle, aiming directly at your subject.
- Focusing rod. Only one rod is included, but there is provision to have two. The rod's length is equal to the focusing distance of the Hyponar. Instead of moving the camera back and forth to focus, just place your subject next to the rod.
- Flash. Inexpensive flash unit. You need to supply a PC cord to connect the flash to the camera. Trial and error to find the proper f-stop to use. You could substitute any flash unit if you want.

The pictures show the flash bracket attached to the Exakta with a Hyponar macro stereo lens. Also, the flash, bracket and rod attached to the camera.
