There are many cameras, including some Exaktas, which have the "universal" 42mm Screw Thread Lens Mount. This Standard Thread has variously been called "Praktica Thread", "Pentax Thread", "42mm Thread" or simply "Universal Thread."

Among the Exaktas with this thread are the Exakta 42 (sometimes referred to as the Exakta Twin TL 42), the Exakta TL-1000, and the Exakta TL-500.

Anticipating your question: No, you cannot use Exakta Bayonet Lenses in any "42", nor can you adapt Exakta Bayonet Lenses to these camera models.

An Automatic Exakta with Universal '42' Thread: The Exakta FE 2000.

Here is another "42" Exakta with Universal Thread, but this one goes a step further: It automatically adjusts the F Stop for the correct Exposure. This System is called: Shutter Speed Preferred Electric Eye (EE) Automation.

My Camera has a Built-in Meter. I don't need a Hand Held Meter. Or do 1?

You certainly do! Built-in meters are terrific but they have their limitations. If you take pictures only in good light, on conventional film, without filters (or only with ordinary filters), if you don't take imaginative pictures, if you never take extreme closeups or copy pictures from books, in short, if you stay within the

snapshot region....you don't need a handheld meter.

But if you ever want to take a picture which is beyond the scope of your built-in meter, you certainly do need a handheld meter. Not just any handheld meter, of course. Some handheld meters don't have a greater range than your built-in meter and if you look at the specifications, you will see that some of the most widely advertised (and high-priced) meters have an amazingly narrow range. True, some go rather high but are deficient in the low end (where the extended range costs money). Others may give fairreadings for the conventional films but not for very slow or very fast films. Still others severely limit the exposure time to hide their limited range.

Finally, before you decide on any Exposure Meter, look at another very important feature; Accuracy. What good is an Exposure Meter if you can't trust it for correct exposure? How do you know? Point the meter and watch the needle. If it bounces back and forth, you know that the meter "can't make up its mind." Make sure the needle goes to the correct reading and





Herbert Keppler, Publisher of Modern Photography Magazine, devoted an entire article to the CAMBRON MONO ZOOM. With his kind permission we reprint excerpts from the article. Does a 500 to 1000mm or more zoom lens you can fit in an average gadget bag tickle your interest a bit?... No, 'tis no Keppler pipe dream but a zoom monocular (half a binocular) which threads onto the front of your camera's normal lens and gives you results equivalent in magnification to a 500-1000mm zoom lens. learned that this particular modern monocular had a magnification range to boggle the mind -10X to 20X- and had been designed to serve equally well as a compact visual telescope and a camera attachment...I snooped on many a subject who didn't dream that I was taking close-ups of him/her, from about a quarter mile or so away (see photos). The monocular is equally usable for animal

photography, and its ability to close focus to

10 ft. allows you to really zero in on a bird.

....To attach it to the front of your camera lens, you use an adapter...Cleverly, the designers have made the eyepiece barrel of rubberish material which minimizes the possibility of causing damage to the lens....A front eyepiece ring controls zooming from 10X to 20X. The front of the Monocular has a focusing ring marked in meters and feet.

....you might get it into your head to stretch things further by using a longer-focal-length normal lens. Can you? Sure. A 100mm camera lens, for instance, gives you a 1000mm to 2000mm equivalent....

How does the MonoZoom compare with a régular 1000mm focal-length lens? The Mono Zoom is remarkably good for the price and convenience but the 1000mm lens (which probably costs ten times as much) is very definitely superior. Ten times as superior? Well.....

And when you tire of poking your lens here and there, you'll find the Mono Zoom an excellent 10-20 X 60mm compact telescope. More fun than a 1000mm lens? I can tell you.

All the above is from Mr. Keppler's article, word for word! We are very proud of the very


enthusiastic evaluation of the CAMBRON Mono Zoom. There is little left for us to add. Mr. Keppler has said it all, more beautifully and more complete than we could have said it. And the pictures are his, too!

We did not test the performance of the Mono Zoom as a 2000mm lens but we take Mr. K's word for it that it works. We did test it with a 50mm lens at focal lengths from 500mm to 1000mm and our own tests gave us results which were just as amazing as those taken by the Magazine (which are reprinted here). We would have liked to see the snooping pictures which Mr. K. mentions but he never showed them to us. Neither did he show us the him/her pictures. Ah, well.....



Exposure Meter for Electronic Strobeflash

When you use Electronic Strobeflash you have to trust the "rating" the manufacturers put on their strobes. They give you a "Guide Number" and wish you Good Luck! Even if we assume that the guide numbers are correct (and more often than not they are anything but correct) there are so many variables that change the amount of light which reaches the subject that the Guide Number can be considered just that: a "guide" but never an accurate mathematical value to give you the actual correct F-Stop.

Things get even worse if you use more than one strobeflash. I would say that all the calculators in the world cannot figure out the correct exposure for multiple flash sources, no matter how many "systems" they devise for doing the figuring. The only way to know, really **know**, is to measure the light that reaches the subject.

Easier said than done. You may have a very good exposure meter but the duration of the flash (say, 1/1000 sec. or less) is far too short to make it possible for your exposure meter to see it, let alone to register it. Now you have two choices: Either you throw away your strobes and use photo floods, quartz lights or other permanent studio lights or, far cheaper and more satisfactory, you use the new Cambron EMES Exposure Meter for Electronic Strobeflash.

Without going into lengthy technical details (which would be of interest solely to electrical engineers) here's what the **Cambron** EMES does: It measures the actual total amount of light reaching the subject regardless whether the light comes directly from the strobe or whether it is bounced off the ceiling, the wall, the floor, or even a mirror! Regardless whether the light comes from a single strobe, two strobes, or a battery of strobes. Regardless how the light is mixed from


direct light and bouncelight. And you don't need a degree from M.I.T. to use the Cambron EMES: You move the sliding indicator to the ASA rating of your film and place the EMES near the subject (an easel is built in) and fire the strobe setup once. The Cambron EMES responds by giving you, electronically, the exact F/Stop at which you set your lens. (You know, of course, that the shutter speed has no influence on the exposure derived from strobeflashes).

To make it even more convenient to obtain the correct exposure reading without walking back to the camera to fire the strobe, you can do the lightmetering and firing from the position of the subject. A Remote Triggering Assembly Device is available as an optional accessory. One end of this unit plugs into the EMES meter. The other end plugs into your strobe with a PC fitting. When you slide the switch on the EMES meter to "ON", the strobe fires and the EMES meter displays the locked-in reading for the correct F-Stop. The connecting cord is more than four yards long and you may be concerned about a time lag in firing. Don't worry: the Remote Triggering Device takes care of this. It has a built-in booster which permits carrying the electric load at a low voltage and boosting it back to full load to assure accurate measurement of the total light.
