THIS VINTAGE EXAKTA THAGEE DRESDEN CAMERA DATES BACK TO THE 1920S. THE LENS ARE MARKED "TESSAR 2,8/50 3953645 CARL ZEISS JENA". THE CAMERA IS ALSO MARKED "GERMANY", NOT MADE IN GERMANY, WHICH DATES IT PRE 1922. INSIDE THE CAMERA. THERE IS A SMALL BOX WHICH HAS THE LETTERS VX IN SIDE

[In the 1920s, such a small box would contain one lens only HR]

Exakta cameras were made in Europe, introduced to the US in 1951 and are now highly collectible. This one is unusual due to the pop-up viewfinder

[True. Most of them have pop-down viewfinders HR]

VERY RARE FIND THIS IS AN "EXA" 35MM SLR, THE FIRST COMMERCIALY SOLD SLR. THE CAMERA IS 65 TO 70 YEARS OLD AND IT WORKS. IT HAS A LOOK DOWN OR SEE THROUGH FINDER, A 50MM F-2.9 MERITAR LENS. ENTIRELY MADE OF METAL, IT WILL DRAW ATTENTION WHEN YOU USE IT. THIS IS THE FORERUNNER OF

THE FAMOUS EXACTA,

I've always hated this camera because of its ass backwards design, left hand wind, slow speed, and self timer operation. It even has a built-in film cutting knife which is useless. Anyway the VX was made in East Germany and has a USSR Occupied stamp. Exacta prisms are easy to come by if the ding on top bothers you. Camera without ding would be a (9)."
